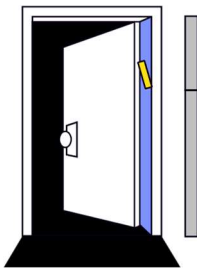
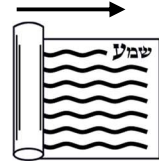


Hanging a Mezuzah



Step 1: Roll the Parchment Roll the parchment from the last word to the first, and place it in the case so the top of the parchment is at the top of the case.



Step 2: Placement of Mezuzah Prepare to attach the mezuzah to the doorpost that is on the right-hand side as you enter the house or room. It should be within the upper third of the doorpost. Fasten it to the doorpost diagonally, with the top of the mezuzah towards the interior of the house or room.

Step 3: Blessing Recite the following words:

Baruch ata Adonai,
Eloheinu Melech
ha-olam, asher kid-shanu
b'mitzvotav vitzivanu
lik-bo'a m'zu-zah.

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי
אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר
קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו וְצִוָּנוּ
לְקַבֵּעַ מְזוּזָה.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Ruler of the universe,
who has sanctified us with Your commandments and commanded us
to affix a mezuzah.

Step 4: Affix the Mezuzah Attach the Mezuzah scroll and case in a permanent way with nails, screw, permanent tape, or in some cases strong magnets.
